1. The ball shop has not yet updated us on the request EC made regarding finding a cheaper shipper to keep cost down. A reminder email has been sent and we will make sure the ball is ordered by early next week.

2. BCC has not sent us the confirmation email to let us know if they are playing the 2021 season. The secretary reports that as per his talk with Shreyas of BCC that he was informed that they don't have enough players to play the 35 over season and they may join in the T20 season. So far, we have confirmed 14 teams.

3. The EC decided as per the AGM to charge each team with \$900 for the 2021 season. GSO had a forfeiture last season when they walked off a game. The EC tasked the President to talk with the umpire and figure this out.

4. Umpiring testing will be conducted over the last weekend of March in all 4 places. Yeshwanth will be contacting the teams to book a room at each place to conduct the test and the Umpiring committee would consist of Krishna, Swapnil and Surya. Yeshwanth will also email all the teams about the test as soon as practical after organizing the rooms and proctors for the test.

5. The EC members volunteered to help Yeshwanth in holding the Umpiring test if needed. The President will help find a venue in OKC. The EC will seek the help of Samir to help Procter in OKC for GSO whose players have difficulty understanding English. Yeshwanth email has started working to receive the EC email.

6. Updates on grounds

A. OKC will have the ground in March and April, the teams there are going to find in a few days what's going to happen after that.

B. BCC is checking with the city to let us use Bartlesville as neutral venue.

C. GCCC is also checking to see if UTE can be used as a neutral venue.

7. The Playing conditions updates will be done by the Secretary and forwarded to the EC members for approval before sending it to the teams.

A. Raman brought up, if there would be borrowing players this season like what was changed in 2020 during covid. The EC is not going to change the rules and it is the same as in the books. However according to existing laws, the team can borrow for batting, bowling and fielding from the opposition of the day, players below 18 years, players above 50, however these borrowed players cannot play in any playoff games, even if they have played the required minimum games. As just a fielder the team can borrow any player from any team.

B. The EC was advised that TSCL does not have a TIN number from the IRS so it cannot open a business accounting its name, the previous treasurer also had dba with Surya as the signatory. This season the same would be done with the Treasurer and President being signatory. An email reply to be send to KV regarding this.
