1. New Balls & Medals:
 - a. The original order has been revised to 260 balls. Additional 44 balls have been ordered from the alternate vendor and have shipped.
 - b. OKC Strikers and D Corp teams have practiced with a new hand stitched ball from the same vendor from Dallas suggested by WSU. Raman has already reached out to the vendor and based on the feedback, these balls could be used as a backup in case of any delays in the shipment of new balls.
2. Reviewing Schedule Draft:
 - a. A draft of the full schedule for the 35 over season was shared by Raman. The members discussed the draft schedule and gave their comments.
 - b. The members shall review the schedule until Memorial Day weekend and finalize it before the end of the week.
 - c. Titans have requested Aug 13th-14th weekend as a blackout date. However, there is a significant possibility of playoffs to happen during that weekend. Surya to email Titans and let them know that they shall be available to play during that weekend if the possibility does arise.
3. Invoice Updates:
 - a. Afzal has emailed out all the invoices to the respective teams.
 - b. Afzal shall notify all the members about the status of the payments that were received and ones that are still pending.
4. Umpiring Updates:
 - a. All the venues for the umpiring test on March 27th have been confirmed. Karthik (OKC Strikers), Samir Shura (ACC), and Krishna/Yeshwanth (GCCC) will be organizing the test in Oklahoma City, Wichita, and Tulsa respectively.
 - b. UC to send out an email to all the teams about the timing and test center locations. Email to include TSCL Documents as attachments.
 - c. Raman shall share the revised and updated 35 over Playing Conditions.
 - d. Raman shall also email WSU, GTCC, SMCC, and GSO and encourage them to attend the umpiring test in good numbers and be well prepared as these teams do not meet the requirement of having minimum number of qualified umpires.
5. Additional Topics:
 - a. Ground situation in OKC: It has been brought to EC's notice that the grounds in OKC will be taken away by the city and the teams are working on getting new grounds at a different location. In order to avoid any confusion on game day, the teams in OKC shall be sent an email asking for an update about the location, names, and the availability of the new grounds.
